

VALUES

TITLE: A kindness is never wasted

AGE GROUP: 7+

DURATION: 30 - 45 min

LEARNING OUTCOME: Enable learners to develop appropriate values, habits and attitudes when handling money

KEY CONCEPTS: Kindness.

MATERIALS NEEDED: Paper, color pencils (depending on activity).

LESSON DESCRIPTION:

Read to the students Aesop's fable about the lion and the mouse. After reading, encourage students to retell the story in their own words.

Encourage conversation with students about what the lesson of this fable would be. Have students reflect on the lesson of this fable with the following questions:

Is it good to be kind? Do you have a story about kindness?

You can end activity in one of the following ways:

- Have students draw a drawing inspired by the lesson of this fable.
- Have students draw a drawing the situation when they were the last kind.
- Have students suggest classroom activities or principles be kinder to others.
- Have students record a video on why it is important to be kind to others.

You can publish their works on a class board or class digital board.
