TITLE: Spot the difference

AGE GROUP: 7+

DURATION: 30 – 45 min

LEARNING OUTCOME: Enable learners to develop appropriate values, habits and attitudes when handling money

KEY CONCEPTS: attention to details, patience, discipline, following the rules, memory

MATERIALS NEEDED: a printed worksheet or the given 2 pictures on a webpage

LESSON DESCRIPTION:

Spot the difference is a fun game that helps children to concentrate, think, and learn to notice detail. At first glance the two images look the same, but if you look hard you'll spot small differences. Talk together about the pictures and give hints if one needs a little help.
